CASII is a Practical and Powerful Tool

AACAP's Child and Adolescent Service Intensity Instrument[®] (CASII) is a standardized assessment tool for mental health providers, care coordinators, insurance benefit administrators, and mental health advocates who provide services for children and adolescents from ages 6 to 18 in the U.S. and other countries.



You can use this tool with varying populations with mental health challenges, including those with medical, substance use, and developmental co-occurring disorders.

CASII helps you to:



Assess treatment effectiveness at a systems level and advocate for needed services.



Measure treatment and intervention outcomes.



Support active participation by child and family.



Create comprehensive, strength-based, individualized, and coordinated service/treatment plans that best match family and child needs.



Speak a common language across a diverse array of providers.
