Under guidance of an AACAP mentor, award recipients work on designing a psychodynamic training project within their child and adolescent psychiatry division and gain access to a network of leaders in psychodynamic child and adolescent psychiatry.

The Mentor requirements include:

- Attend an all-day project planning session on Monday of AACAP's Annual Meeting
- Assist the awardee in conceptualizing, designing, and completing a project
- Call/chat/meet with your assigned mentee approximately monthly
- Attend quarterly check-ins with the PsyFI Leadership Team
- Attend your mentee's presentation of their project after completion (date TBD)
- Mentors can receive a stipend of up to \$200
- Participation in PsyFI alumni networking events is strongly encouraged
